Land Governance for Development

Land Governance for Equitable and Sustainable Development

Large-scale acquisition of land in the Global South has received a great deal of interest in the last few years. This course provides a multidisciplinary analysis of the 'land rush' within the more general context of land governance in Africa, Asia and Latin America. We will look at the history and drivers, the diversity of stakeholders and networks involved, the urgency of current challenges and innovative governance solutions.

Due to the current Covid-19 pandemic this course is offered **online**. Covid-19 and the measures taken worldwide to curb the pandemic are of great concern to the land governance community, as alarming observations are coming in about the loss of livelihoods and deepening poverty, government crackdowns on civil society, the suspension of land administration services and irregular land acquisition. We will also reflect on these current developments and immediate effects of the pandemic, and how it might change the future work of the land governance community.

The course is organized by LANDac - The Netherlands Land Academy - hosted by Utrecht University, the Netherlands. Students and professionals will acquire up- to-date knowledge on new land pressures and learn how to place these in broader theoretical contexts and policy debates. Participants learn about best practices in land governance from different perspectives and on multiple levels, from local to international. Topics are discussed in interactive minicourses and lectures. The design of the course allows for participants to closely work together with professionals, experts and fellow students from a variety of backgrounds. **The course provides participants** with thorough knowledge of current problems as well as academic and policy debates related to land and development. Participants also build understanding of practical knowledge and possible solutions. The guiding question is how to optimize the link between land governance, inclusive sustainable development and poverty alleviation.

Lecturers include prof dr Annelies Zoomers, dr Guus van Westen, dr Gemma van der Haar, prof dr Jaap Zevenbergen, dr Griet Steel, dr Mayke Kaag, dr Femke van Noorloos, dr Murtah Shannon, Romy Santpoort, LANDac fellows from the Professional Learning Porgramme, and others.
